He is a consultant to governments, health departments and not for profits on the importance of involving lived experience and expertise in policy and program development. Dr Smith has lived experience/expertise in child abuse, out-of-home care, juvenile justice, substance abuse/addiction, homelessness, poverty and successful life planning and career management. Dr Smith is co-chair and Director for the End Street Sleeping Collaboration which is a New South Wales Premiers Priority Project to make street sleeping rare, brief and non-reoccurring. He is also a global consultant for the Institute of Relational Health for CareSource and Pale Blue in the USA. He is the Patron for Signal Flare in Queensland and several not-for-profit organisations addressing some of the needs of the more vulnerable across several states in Australia. He is a co-founder of Voiceup Australia which provides a safe space for people traumatised as children to speak their truth. Dr Smith is the author of 'Out of the forest' (2018) and 'Better than Happiness: The True Antidote to Discontent' (2023) both published by Penguin Random House. He also has a TEDx talk which has had more than 1 million views.

Frank has enjoyed success in both coaching and administration here in Australia and overseas, in a career spanning 35 years. He was on the coaching staff for the Australian Kangaroos and Manly-Warringah Sea Eagles under Bob Fulton in the 1990's, he spent five years based in Europe as a Rugby Union defensive coach, and he was a consultant for the South African Springboks during the 2003 World Cup. During his 17 years at the Storm, Frank has been a part of four NRL premierships, seven Grand Final appearances, six Minor Premierships, and 12 Preliminary Finals. In 2024, Frank has driven the establishment of the Melbourne Storm Pathways Program to ensure the future success of the club. Also in 2024, Frank was Manager of the NSW State of Origin Team coached by Michael Maguire, that became only the third Blues team in Origin history to win a decider at Lang Park.
